Well.. I found the problem...the wires at the camera connector on the harness are able to move inside the connector (meaning they loose contact with the connector pins). As such, this is why the camera will work intermittently...the wires at the harness connect all the way with the pins, but during driving or when the weather gets hot, the plastic at the connector expands, causing the wires to slip back and loose their connection. Any suggestion as how I might be able to fix this? I think for now, I am going to get some electrical tape, push the wires all the way into the connector, and tape off to prevent them from moving around.




